OUR PURPOSE STATEMENT

Why we exist as a church

Our purpose statement: Grassy Valley Baptist Church exist to be a family of Believers who have an Authentic Passion for Jesus and others.

How do we accomplish this task?

By obeying the "Great Commandment" and the "Great Commission".

The Great Commandment: Matt 22:36-40 "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?" And He said to him," You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind. "This is the great and foremost commandment. "The second is like it, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' "On these two commandments depend the whole Law and the Prophets."

The Great Commission: Matt 28:19-20 "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

- To "Love God with all your heart" is **Worship.**
- > To "Love your neighbor as yourself" is **Ministry**.
- ➤ To "Go...make disciples" is **Evangelism.**
- > To "baptize..." is to incorporate into Fellowship.
- To "Teach them to obey all things" is **Discipleship.**

Evangelism

Eph 3:10 in order that the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known through the church to the rulers and the authorities in the heavenly {places.}

Rom 10:13-14 for "Whoever will call upon the name of the Lord will be saved." How then shall they call upon Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher?

Fellowship

Ps 133:1 Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brothers to dwell together in unity!

I Jn 1:7 but if we walk in the light as He Himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.

We exist to educate God's people

Discipleship

Heb 6:1 Therefore leaving the elementary teaching about the Christ, let us press on to maturity...

2 Pet 3:18 but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Eph 4:11-13 And He gave some {as} apostles, and some {as} prophets, and some {as} evangelists, and some {as} pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ; until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ.

OUR FAITH

What We Believe

➤ In essential beliefs – we have <u>unity</u>.

Eph 4:4-6 {There is} one body and one Spirit, just as also you were called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all who is over all and through all and in all.

➤ In non-essential beliefs – we have <u>liberty</u>.

Rom 14:4, 12, 22 Who are you to judge the servant of another? To his own master he stands or falls; and stand he will, for the Lord is able to make him stand. (12) So then each one of us shall give account of himself to God. (22) The faith which you have, have as your own conviction before God. Happy is he who does not condemn himself in what he approves.

➤ In all our beliefs – we show <u>love</u>.

1 Cor 13:2 And if I have {the gift of} prophecy, and know all mysteries and all knowledge; and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing.

What we practice!

Beliefs that are not translated into every day living are of very little use. Based on what the Bible teaches, we at GVBC feel very strongly about the following seven practices:

Bible as our sole authority.

2 Tim 3:16-17 All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.

Since God's Word is the only completely reliable and truthful authority, being God's revelation of Himself to us, sent from Him without any mixture of error, we accept the Bible as our manual for living. Our first question when faced with a decision is, "What does the Bible say?" We practice daily Bible reading, Bible study and Bible memorization. The Bible is the basis for all we believe.

Autonomy of each local church.

Col 1:18 He is also head of the body, the church; and He is the beginning, the first-born from the dead; so that He Himself might come to have first place in everything.

Jesus Christ is the head of our church; not any person, group or religious organization. While recognizing the value of associating and cooperating with other groups of Christians, we believe every local church should be self-governing and independent of any denominational control. Operating under the Headship of Christ we recognize the equal responsibility of every member.

Priesthood of every believer.

1 Pet 2:9 But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for {God's} own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

The Bible teaches that every Christian is called to "full time" Christian service, regardless of his or her vocation. At GVBC we practice the truth that every believer is a minister by encouraging every member to find a place of service and ministry. Every believer has direct access to God through prayer and Bible reading.

\mathbf{T} ithing.

Lev 27:30 'Thus all the tithe of the land, of the seed of the land or of the fruit of the tree, is the LORD'S; it is holy to the LORD.

At GVBC we practice tithing for the support of Christ's Body, the local church, as God commands. We recognize that giving 10% of all of our income is the Biblical standard of giving.

mmersion

Col 2:12 having been buried with Him in baptism, in which you were also raised up with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead.

We practice baptism by immersion under water – the way Jesus was baptized, and the way the Bible commands.

Spirit-led living.

John 15:5 "I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me, and I in him, he bears much fruit; for apart from Me you can do nothing.

We realize that the only way possible to live the Christian life is by God's power within us. Therefore, we seek to practice a daily dependence on God's Spirit to enable us to do what is right. (Philippians 2:13; Ephesians 5:18)

Telling others about Jesus Christ

1 Pet 3:15 but sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts, always {being} ready to make a defense to everyone who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you, yet with gentleness and reverence;

It is the responsibility of every Christian to share the Good News with those God brings along our daily path. We practice <u>personal</u> sharing about Jesus Christ and inviting our friends to church.
